The voice of the French goat industry

Created in 1983, ANICAP represents:

- Goat's milk producers, through the National Federation of Goat Farmers (**FNEC**)
- Private and cooperative goat's milk processors, through their respective federations: the National Federation of Dairy Industries (**FNIL**) and the National Federation of Dairy Cooperatives (**FNCL**)

In 2012, the French goat industry represented:

485 million litres of goat's milk processed by dairies

120 million litres processed in farms

Or a total of 600 million litres of milk produced and processed, and 110,000 tonnes of goat's cheese

MISSIONS AND FIELDS OF ACTIVITY

ORGANIZING THE FRENCH GOAT INDUSTRY

ANICAP brings together all goat's milk producers and processors to define joint strategic orientations that can be implemented within the organization. In particular, it helps to keep the goat industry's stakeholders informed on the market context, and contributes to the development of a contractual policy.

ENSURING COLLECTIVE PROMOTION

ANICAP carries out collective promotional campaigns on French goat's cheeses to boost sales in France and abroad. Currently, four promotional campaigns are being carried out in the French, UK, German and US markets.

SUPPORTING TECHNICAL PROJECTS

ANICAP helps to fund projects aimed at developing the industry; for example, work on a shared code of farming best practices, the quality of goat's milk products and genetic improvements.

GOVERNING BODIES

ANICAP is managed by a Governing Board and a General Assembly, which are composed of representatives of its three member federations.

ANICAP is chaired by a representative of each of the three federations in turn for a three-year term.
